

9/8/1982 - Tom Genske (County Surveyor) found nail, excavated a 5' x 10' x 4' deep excavation 2' below road base found pieces of broken limestone but nothing identifiable, nail was located on centerlines of pavement, accepted nail as corner.

4/1986 - Tom Genske (surveyor) set monument


