





## HOW WE HELP -

We will meet to talk with you wherever it is most convenient for you – in our office, in your home, over the phone, or by email.

We can answer questions and provide information when you are faced with making decisions during confusing and difficult times.



## WE CAN HELP you:

- Maintain or regain your independence in the community.
- Find services to help you be as independent as possible.
- Make plans for your future housing and care needs.
- Locate health and housing assistance.
- Apply for public benefit programs such as Medicare, Social Security, or Medicaid.
- Connect with prevention and health promotion programs.
- Apply for publicly funded long term care programs such as Family Care, Partnership, or IRIS.
- Evaluate your eligibility for financial benefits.
- Fulfill your role as a caregiver.
